



Resolution 2008-06:

Qualification to the Wall of Honor

1. Resident of Delhi for twelve continuous months with two exceptions: a. killed in action, b. is still on active.
2. Proof of honorable discharge from any branch of the armed services. (DD214 separation papers, discharge certificate, or any other armed forces recognized papers or pictures.)
3. Anyone who served on active duty in any branch of the armed services before 1980. After 1980 you must have served on active duty, or been in combat zone for at least thirty days or less than thirty days if the action was over.
4. National Guard or Reserve time counts, only if you were called to active duty for twelve continuous months, or in a combat zone for thirty days, or less if the action was over, or killed in action.
5. Other special events that might have happened to you will be considered.
6. All veterans names that have hereby been submitted since the incorporation of the Wall of Honor project have qualified under the qualifications as described in paragraphs one through four.
7. The Delhi Township Veterans Association will not be liable for any false information provided by person submitting veteran names; and the Delhi Township Veterans Association reserves the right to disqualify any veteran name submitted based on the false information provided.

By the authority and the duty of the Constitution we, the undersigned, attest to the witness of the approval of this resolution by the Board of Trustees.
