





Resolution 2010-16:

### Qualifications to the Wall of Honor

1. Resident of Delhi for twelve consecutive months with two exceptions: 1) killed in action and 2) is still on active.
2. Proof of honorable discharge from any branch of the armed services. (DD214 separation papers, discharge certificate, or any other armed forces recognized papers or pictures.)
3. The name being submitted must have been honorably discharged or currently serving honorably on active duty under the at least one of the following qualification requirements.
  - a. Served on active duty for 12 consecutive months.
  - b. Served on active duty in a combat zone for at least 30 days.
  - c. Served on active duty in a combat zone for less than 30 days, provided that the action ended within that 30 day period.
  - d. Killed in Action
4. National Guard or Reserve time counts, only if the person meets the one of the qualifications in §3 of this resolution.
5. The Board of Trustees reserves the right to accept other special and/or unusual circumstances and/or conditions that may have occurred to the name being submitted while serving on active duty by examining documentation of proof of said circumstances and/or conditions.
6. All veterans' names to this date that have hereby been submitted since the incorporation of the Wall of Honor project will be considered qualified under this resolution.
7. The Delhi Township Veterans Association will not be liable for any false information provided by person submitting veteran names; and the Delhi Township Veterans Association reserves the right to disqualify any veteran name submitted based on the false information provided
8. Wall of Honor Application (F-0001) must be completed in its entirety and proper military proof as described in §2 of this resolution which supports the application must be submitted as necessary documents for the processing of the name for the Wall of Honor Monument.
9. This resolution supersedes and repeals Resolution 2008-06.
